Introduction

Study-in-Japan Fair has been conducted by Cambodia-Japan Cooperation Center (CJCC) since 2008 with continuous support from the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sport (MoEYS), Embassy of Japan in Cambodia, Royal University of Phnom Penh (RUPP), Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), other Cambodian and Japanese educational institutions. This year, in a close collaboration with Study in Japan Global Network Project in ASEAN/Okayama university, the Study-in-Japan Fair 2022 was conducted from October 14 to October 16 in order to promote the study in Japan and share information to the public, especially students who are interested in pursuing their higher education in Japan.

This year, before our main event CJCC also organized a virtual meeting with our honorable guest speaker from Royal University of Phnom Penh (RUPP), Dr. Mam Socheath, under the topic "Brief of Education in Cambodia". The purpose of this meeting was to share general educational information about Cambodia. The fair was successfully completed with the participation of 7 Japanese universities, a company and 1,026 students, parents and those who wish to pursue their study in Japan and wish to know about study in Japan information.


